Bearspaw Golf Club has a rich history of supporting and developing Junior Golfers and we are proud to continue that legacy. The goal of our program is to provide opportunities for Junior Golfers to learn and develop their game in a fun and supportive environment.

Enclosed is an overview of our Junior events for the season. There are a variety of options for Junior golfers of all ages and experience levels. Some programs are for our Junior members only, however certain programs are open to non-member youngsters as well.

Please note our new 3 Tier system explained in this booklet, which helps separate Juniors by skill and experience, so they can fit in to the proper programs to excel their development. Each program has the tiers which apply to that group next to the program name. We are also excited to begin implementing the Operation 36 model for the 2024 season into many of our group lessons and Junior Nights. The goal of Operation 36 is to teach Juniors how to shoot 36 on 9 holes, beginning at 25 yards, allowing them to graduate to new levels when they complete level 1.

2024 JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Bearspaw Golf Club takes pride in all of its members and facilities. Golf is a game of respect and honour for yourself, your fellow competitors and the golf course. The Code of Conduct below identifies the basic standards we require from our Junior golfers at Bearspaw Golf Club.

DRESS CODE:

Proper golf attire is required while using the golf facilities. This includes:

- Clothing worn in a neat and respectable manner.
- Collared shirts for boys and for girls either golf tops or golf dresses.
- Tailored golf pants, tailored joggers, golf shorts or skirts for girls.
- Boys shirts preferably tucked in.
- Jeans, sweat pants, short shorts, all athletic wear, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts (boys) are not permitted.
- Hats to be worn forward at all times.

GOLF CART POLICY

Juniors at Bearspaw are expected to walk their rounds. Juniors with a valid driver's license and at least 16 years of age may, on occasion, take a power cart if conditions allow, paying the full fee for their round and checking into the golf course. For example, pace of play needed to be quicker, inclement weather projected, extreme hot conditions, or if the Junior has some type of injury that prohibits walking the course. If a Junior takes a cart under these conditions it is expected they follow our guidelines of respecting the course and fellow golfers and driving the golf cart in a responsible manner and following all signage on the course. There is a one strike policy in regard to golf cart and abuse of the rules, checking in, or not paying for carts, which will result in an immediate suspension of golf cart privileges for the remainder of the golf season.

ALCOHOL, TOBACCO OR DRUGS

Use of drugs will not be tolerated. Use of alcohol and tobacco is not permitted at the golf course. For Juniors who are 18 years of age, use of these products is not permitted at Junior events.

BEHAVIOUR AT OTHER CLUBS

When visiting other golf clubs, you are a guest and are representing yourself as well as Bearspaw. We ask you respect the values, standards and policies of the host club when visiting and represent Bearspaw in a professional and positive fashion.

GOLF COURSE AND CLUBHOUSE BEHAVIOUR

The golf club is an adult environment and although we always promote having fun, we ask you respect other patrons of the course and behave in a mature manner at all times. Abusive or inappropriate conduct or language, including temperamental outbursts, throwing or breaking of clubs, any form of cheating or abuse of the golf course or the facilities is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. Any disrespect of the golf course, golf shop or serving staff will not be tolerated.

VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

If a minor violation occurs, the individual will be prohibited from further participation until he/she complies with the above code and will be given a written warning. The individual must do so without delay and maintain the standard. Any actions considered serious may result in the individual being removed or excluded from any Junior Programs or activities until the incident is reviewed by the Professional Staff. Multiple written warnings will come with a suspension of playing rights and potentiall dismissal from the program.

- Allow Juniors to make new friends and build life long relationships.

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

BEARSPAW JUNIOR ACADEMY OPERATION 36 - TIER 1 & 2

Formerly known as Out of Hibernation and the June-yer lesson groups, we are excited to implement our new Operation 36 Junior Lesson Program. There will be 2 semesters to this program and juniors can register for either 1 or both if they choose. The Operation 36 model is based on the goal of developing a juniors game so they can shoot a score of 36 (even par) over 9 holes. There will be 8 lesson sessions in each semester to teach and develop skills for Juniors' short game and full swing.

In addition Juniors are expected to participate in the Sunday Junior Night/ Operation 36 Play Night where they put their skills to the test. On the play nights each Junior will start from Level 1 which is 25 yards, with the goal to shoot 36 from this level before advancing to level 2 which is 50 yards, and so on. Junior members are welcome to each Junior Night at no charge and non-members are welcome to 4 of the Junior Night play nights for each semester they register for.

JUNIOR NIGHT & SUNDAY PLAYERS LEAGUE - ALL TIERS

Once a week on Sunday afternoons Bearspaw will host our Junior Night featuring the Players League starting at 4:00PM and the more casual fun play beginning at 5:00PM. Players League Juniors will compete in a different game each week such as low net, low gross, team alternate shot, team scramble etc.

This is recommended for juniors age 11-18 who are more focused on competitive play. Juniors playing in the Junior night times beginning at 5:00PM are recommended to adopt the Operation 36 model, using the OP36 app to play from their level (beginning at level 1 for all players) and aiming to shoot 36 over 9 holes to advance to the next level. For more information on the Operation 36 model and programs see the section titled 'Bearspaw Junior Academy Operation 36' in the program.

We will cover every aspect of the game from the swing, mental preparation, course management, tournament preparation, body preparation, and equipment.

This will be done in a 60 minute group lesson setting on a weekly basis, combined with compete sessions of 9 holes on the course.
